

Incumbent is responsible for performing plumbing work at the journeyman level in the maintenance shop, in GO and STL residences or on the Embassy compound

Major Duties and Responsibilities

Incumbent is required to perform the full spectrum of plumbing work: installation, maintenance, and repair of bathroom fixtures, water heaters, swimming pool filters, residential pressure pumps, water filtration units, sewer systems and other plumbing-related duties in GO owned and STGL residences. Must also perform preventive maintenance on hot water heaters installed in GO and STG-leased residences. Will be called upon to disassemble and re-assemble those items needing repair and may have to fabricate new parts when needed.

Incumbent is required to perform basic carpentry work on the Mission compound, in particular to the structures, office furniture, and residential and government-leased building. Taking instructions (official approval) from supervisor must assist building furniture, wooden doors, wire screen doors, windows and shelves for offices and residences. Will also be called upon to repair all of the above, usually by assessing what is needed and then gathering the proper tools and supplies to complete the job. Must also be able to disassemble those items requiring repair and either builds a replacement part or makes recommendations as to what part should be purchased.

Incumbent must have a basic electrical knowledge to be able to perform inspection and basic repairs as needed.

Assist with additional maintenance – related projects when requested to do so by Maintenance Foreman or Maintenance Supervisor.
